CHIEF MASTER SERGEANT LATASHA S. MITCHELL

Chief Master Sergeant LaTasha S. Mitchell is the 136th Force Support Squadron Superintendent assigned to the Naval Air Station Fort Worth Joint Reserve Base, Texas. Chief Mitchell serves as the chief enlisted manager for the Manpower and Personnel Flight as well as the Services Sustainment Flight. She is the commander's principal advisor on all matters influencing the health and morale of squadron members as well as the advisor to commanders on manpower, personnel and services sustainment matters.

Chief Mitchell began her military career in the Colorado Air National Guard in 1997 as a Personnel Craftsman in the Mission Support Flight. As a traditional guardsman, she attended school full-time and worked as a civilian with U.S. Environmental Protection Agency. In May of 2002, Chief Mitchell accepted an Active Guard/Reserve (AGR) position with the Mission Support Flight as the Career Development NCOIC. During the period of May 2002 to Feb 2011, Chief Mitchell worked in many different sections within the Military Personnel Flight. She also supported Operations NOBLE EAGLE, IRAQ FREEDOM and ENDURING FREEDOM during her time with the 140th Wing.



In 2011, Chief Mitchell was accepted into the Air National Guard Statutory Program and was assigned to Headquarters, Air Reserve Personnel Center in Denver, Colorado as an ANG Separations team lead eventually transitioning to the Superintendent for Reserve and ANG Separations while still in the Stat tour program. In 2013, Chief Mitchell left the statutory tour program and entered back into the State AGR program as the Military Personnel Management Superintendent at State Headquarters. In 2015, Chief Mitchell transferred to the 136th Airlift Wing in Fort Worth, Texas as the Force Support Squadron Superintendent. While there, Chief Mitchell was handpicked to be the first Chief from the Wing to complete the TAG Leadership Development program honing her strategic leadership and future process skills. She graduated from the program in 2017 with 18 other future leaders in the Texas Military Department. In January of 2019, Chief Mitchell was selected as the Wing Command Chief for the 136th Airlift Wing where she is currently serving.
